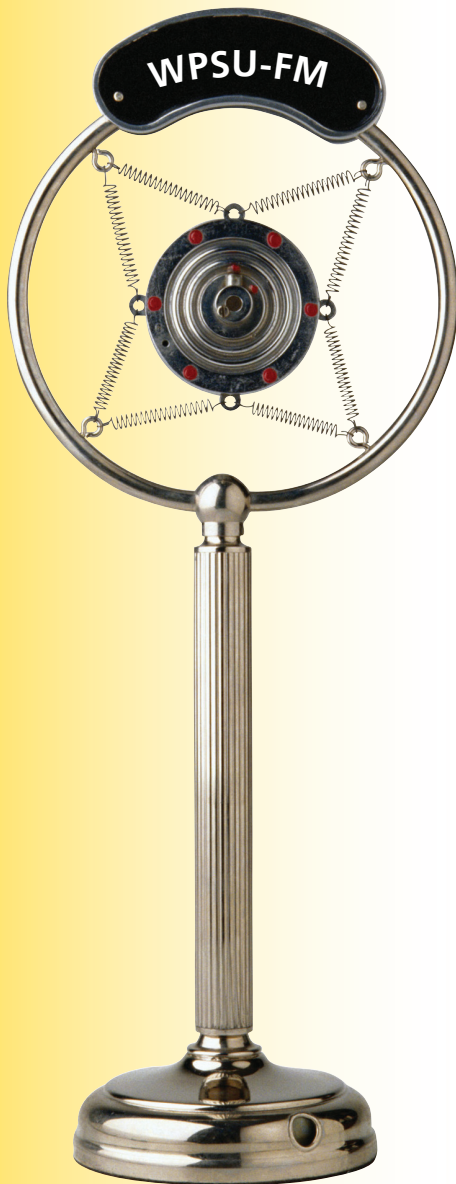


BookMark

Read any good books lately? Talk about them on the radio!



BookMark: It's a weekly short-format program that airs on your NPR station, WPSU-FM.

Who can review books for the program? Anyone who likes to read and lives in the WPSU-FM listening area.

What books are right for the show? New releases and books by Pennsylvania authors are preferred, but classics will be considered if the reviewer is able to shed new light on the respective book.

How do I become a reviewer? Simply write a brief book review (no more than 400 words) about a book you either loved or hated. Your review should include interesting information about the author; a brief sketch of the characters, setting, and plot; what you liked and didn't like about the book, etc. If your review meets our criteria, we'll arrange to have it recorded and broadcast on WPSU-FM.

Please note: Writing for radio is different from writing for print. A **BookMark** review is meant to be read aloud, so be sure to use short sentences and write in a conversational style.

Be sure to include your name, address, daytime phone number, and e-mail address. If your book is right for **BookMark**, we'll be in touch with more details. Reviews will not be returned.
