

The service, available at no additional cost to Comcast Digital Cable customers, brings hundreds of hours of interviews, instructional and educational videos, documentaries, and newly uncovered archival material to consumers on their own schedule. The first-of-its-kind agreement gives Comcast customers unprecedented access to an ever-expanding catalog of materials.

New Penn State ON DEMAND programs are added on a weekly basis. To view programs, Comcast Digital Cable customers can tune to Channel 1 on their Digital Cable lineup or press the ON DEMAND button on their remote control, then click on the "Get Local" section ("Your Town" in the Pittsburgh region) to find the Penn State ON DEMAND category.

Any programs available on Penn State ON DEMAND are also available online through Penn State's video portal at *www.live.psu.edu/vod*. The content will remain archived online and will be available to watch, after the program has expired from Penn State ON DEMAND. These sites will also offer related Penn State content.
